

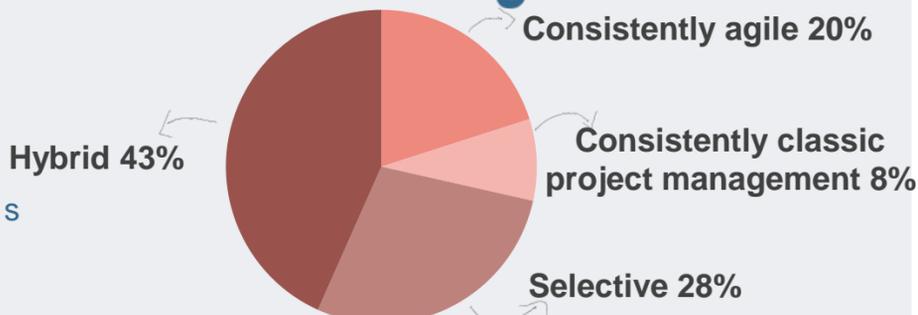

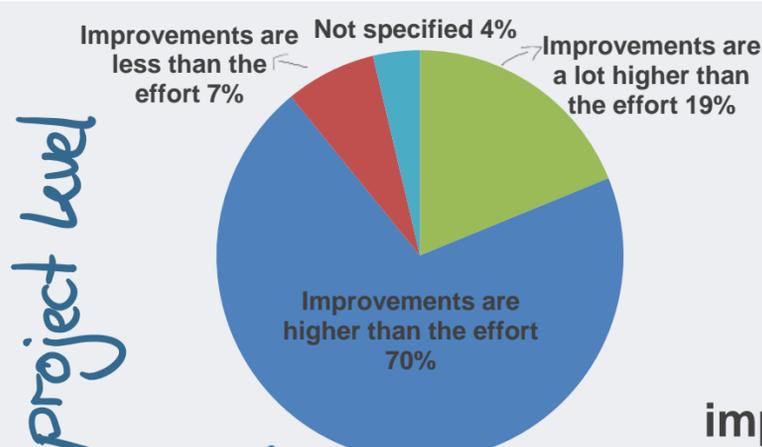
Hybrid most common!

With **84%**, Scrum is still the most used agile approach at team level. This is followed by Kanban, DevOps, Lean and Design Thinking.

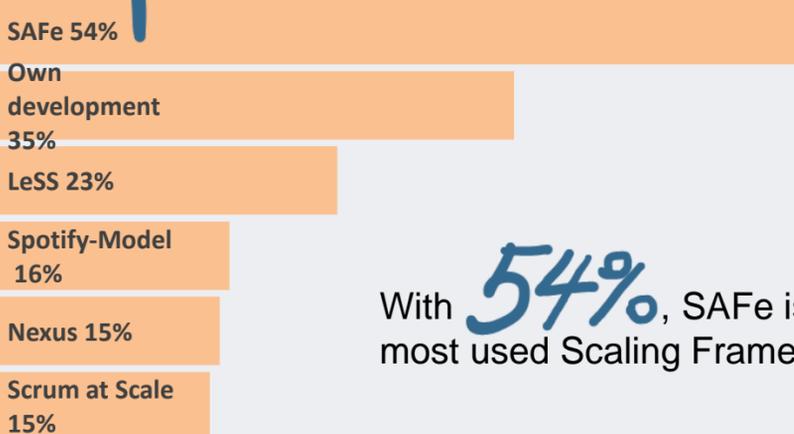
improvements vs. efforts

Top 6 USED SCALING FRAMEWORKS



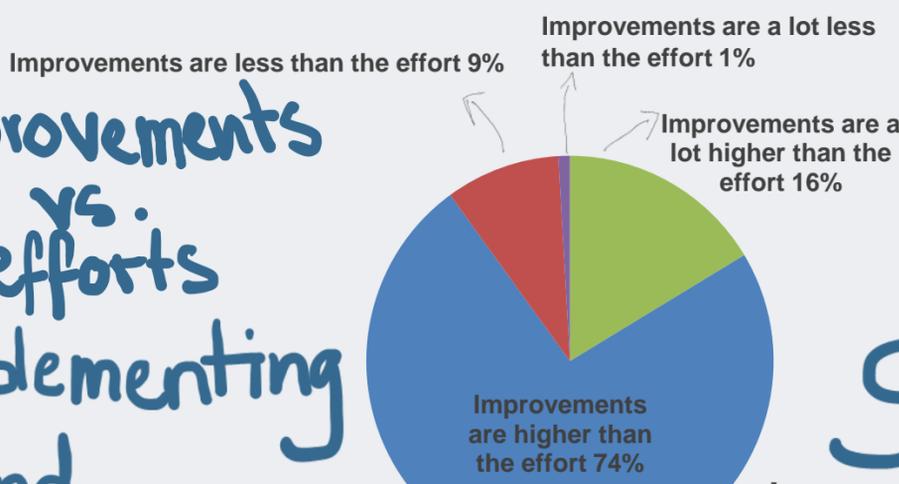
With **54%**, SFAFe is the most used Scaling Framework
